SUPERPOSITION

COUL STUDIO is a group of Korean artists of four members, founded in Munich, Germany. COUL STUDIO explores on conceptual art by investigating a variety of art materials. Each member of this group is a student or a graduate in different fields of study in Munich. Hana Kim is studying art in Art Academy of Munich (ADBK). Yeseul Park is a material scientist, graduated from the Technical University of Munich (TUM). Hyunjong Jeon is studying in the field of physics at the University of Munich (LMU). Dabin Kim is a medical student in TUM.

The theme of this exhibition is "Superposition", a frequently coined terminology in physics. It describes the overlapping of physical status, such as repeated overlapping of waves at the same position. In this exhibition, COUL STUDIO presents the superposition in real space: in nature and in human societies by articulating with varied media including photography, painting, videos and installations. In parallel, the virtual space created with a computer programming by COUL STUDIO superposes with real spatial experience under conceptual construction. Superposition also represents the formation of a new 'artistic status' provoked by the combination of individual artistic status of its diverse members.

COUL STUDIO members aim to push the boundaries of art by further investigative series, casting fundamental questions on them. Armed with the tools of communication and a presentation of seamless integration of real and virtual space, COUL STUDIO conveys to the world its artistic viewpoints and experiences.
